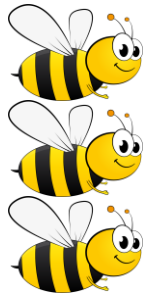

We do ask during window visits that windows stay closed unless visitors and residents both wear a mask and are at least six feet apart.

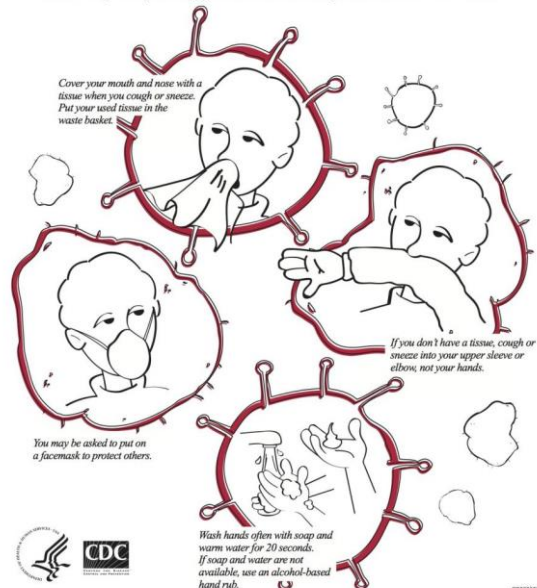
COVID-19 UPDATE

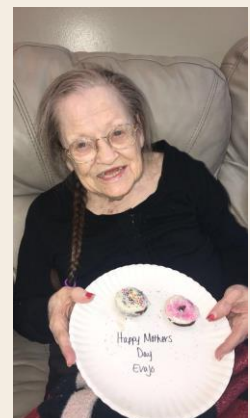
